

BYLAW NO. 37

A BYLAW OF THE MUNICIPAL DISTRICT OF CLEAR HILLS NO. 21, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ESTABLISHING REASONABLE FEES FOR THE PURCHASE OF GOODS AND SERVICES.

WHEREAS, Section 6 of the Municipal Government Act of Alberta, 1994 being Chapter M-26.1, states that a municipality has natural person powers, except to the extent that they are limited by this or any other enactment; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Municipal District of Clear Hills No. 21 desire to establish reasonable fees for the purchase of various goods and services.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Municipal District of Clear Hills No. 21, in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

1. A Schedule of Fees shall be attached to this bylaw, establishing fees for the purchase of various goods and services.
2. The Schedule of Fees may be amended from time to time by a resolution of Council passed at a duly constituted meeting of the Council of the Municipal District of Clear Hills No. 21.
3. This Bylaw shall come into force and effect on the date of final reading hereof.

Schedule of Fees – Purchase of Goods & Services

The amount which Clear Hills County may pay for the supply of goods and services shall be the amounts listed on this schedule.

Fencing rates (covers all material & labor costs - no cash in lieu) \$1,800.00 per half mile

Compensation may be paid for disturbance outside of the existing road allowance

Right of Way Acquisition:

 Land classified as unimproved pasture (native land) \$150.00 per acre

 Land classified as cultivated or improved pasture \$300.00 per acre

Right of Way Acquisition – Subdivision Land:

 Land classified as unimproved pasture (native land) \$450.00 per acre

 Land classified as cultivated or improved pasture \$450.00 per acre

Land Use Agreements:

 Land classified as unimproved pasture (native land) \$100.00 per acre

 Land classified as cultivated, underseeded to hay or improved pasture \$200.00 per acre

Compensation for Borrow Pits \$500.00 per pit
