

BYLAW NO. 54

A BYLAW OF THE MUNICIPAL DISTRICT OF CLEAR HILLS NO. 21, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, FOR THE PURPOSE OF RESCINDING MINISTERIAL ORDER NO. 248/82 – DESIGNATING QUACK GRASS AS A NOXIOUS WEED.

WHEREAS, the Weed Control Act provides that a local authority may, by bylaw, designate plants within the municipality as restricted, noxious or nuisance weeds, and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Municipal District of Clear Hills No. 21, desire to rescind Ministerial Order No. 248/82 designating quack grass as a noxious weed.


NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Municipal District of Clear Hills No. 21, in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

1. That Ministerial Order No. 248/82 is hereby rescinded.
2. That Quackgrass is designated as a nuisance weed in the Municipal District of Clear Hills No. 21.
3. This bylaw shall come into force and effect on the date of final reading hereof.


