

BYLAW NO. 77-04

A BYLAW OF THE MUNICIPAL DISTRICT OF CLEAR HILLS, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ESTABLISHING **CERTAIN DESIGNATED OFFICER POSITIONS**.

WHEREAS, the Council of the Municipal District of Clear Hills (hereinafter referred to as "the M.D.") wishes to establish certain designated officer positions; and


WHEREAS, the Council of the Municipal District of Clear Hills has determined it is in the best interests of the municipality to pass such a bylaw.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Municipal District of Clear Hills, in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

1. THAT, this bylaw shall be cited as the "Designated Officer Bylaw".
2. THAT, in this bylaw, unless the context otherwise requires:
 - a) **Council** means the Council of the Municipal District of Clear Hills.
 - b) **Director of Corporate and Community Services** of the Municipal District of Clear Hills and whatever subsequent title may be conferred on that officer by Council.
 - c) **Assessor** means a person who has the qualifications set out in the Municipal Government Act to carry out the duties and responsibilities of an Assessor under that Act.
 - d) **Municipality** means the corporation of the Municipal District of Clear Hills, and where the context so requires, means the land included in the boundaries of the Municipal District.
 - e) **Designated Officer** shall mean a Designated Officer within the meaning of the Municipal Government Act.
 - e) **Municipal Government Act** shall mean the Municipal Government Act, Statutes of Alberta, 1994, c.M-26.1 and amendments thereto.
3. THAT, the following Designated Officer positions are established, and the person(s) appointed these positions will have the following titles:
 - a) Director of Corporate and Community Services, to carry out the powers, duties and functions set out in the job description for each position as established by the Chief Administrative Officer for the Municipal District of Clear Hills.
 - b) Assessor, to carry out the duties and responsibilities of an assessor as designated in the Municipal Government Act.
4. THAT, Council will by resolution appoint individuals to the Designated Officer positions established by this bylaw.
5. THAT, Designated Officers are hereby authorized to further delegate, and to authorize for the delegation of any matter delegated to them by the Chief Administrative Officer to any employee of the municipality.

6. THAT, all Designated Officers are accountable to the Chief Administrative Officer for the exercise of their powers, duties and functions.
7. THAT, this bylaw rescinds all previous Bylaws that pertain to this action, namely Bylaw No. 64-03 dated February 11, 2004.
8. THAT, this bylaw shall come into force and effect upon the date of final reading hereof .
