



# Clear Hills County

Title: <b>FENCING</b>	

## 1. Policy Statement

- 1.1 Clear Hills County will replace fences it destroys or damages while undertaking municipal operation, unless otherwise agreed upon (i.e. in the case of an unused and dilapidated or decrepit fence).

## 2. Standards

- 2.1. Replacement fences will be constructed to the standard currently in place or to the following standards; whichever is of the higher quality (i.e. game fence):

- 2.1.1. In all other instances fences will be replaced to the standard that existed prior to the fences being removed;

- 2.1.2. If the landowner wants to raise the fence to a higher standard he could compensate the County up to the standard he would require;

### 2.2. Current Standards

- 2.2.1. Three wire fencing with Canadian Double Strand standard wire;

- 2.2.2. Treated posts with a minimum diameter of 3 inches and a length of 6 feet; varying post lengths may be used where conditions warrant;

- 2.2.3. Posts are to be placed approximately 18 to 20 feet apart;

- 2.2.4. Corner fence construction may be to the landowner's requirements

## 3. General

- 3.1 The county will only replace existing fences. If no fence exists or a lower quality fence than standards as per Section 2.2, with evidence of not being used exists, the county will not be obligated to construct a fence.

- 3.2 During County operations, fences that are in the right of way will not be repaired or replaced if damaged.
