Dear Mr. Wallace,

On behalf of Clear Hills County Agricultural Service Board, I would like to thank you for taking the time to speak to Mr. Greg Coon, our agricultural fieldman regarding the long-term plan for ACIS weather stations. The information you provided generated a great deal of discussion among the Board members. In your discussions with Greg, you indicated that your group is always looking for feedback and suggestions to improve the system. This letter is to provide some suggestions for improving weather station coverage in our county for use by AFSC.

The Clear Hills County Agricultural Service Board recognizes the importance of having area representative weather data for producers, to ensure such programs such as the Moisture Deficiency Insurance and Moisture Deficiency Endorsement programs are administered to producers in an accurate way. We believe that the ACIS target of having no more than twenty kilometers between weather stations is a step in the right direction, however, the Board, after much discussion came up with the suggestion of providing less complex and less expensive, more portable weather stations that could be issued to producers that are registered for AFSC programs that are contingent on precipitation data. That way, each producer's data would be much more area accurate.

The second suggestion revolves around your concern with finding manpower to maintain and repair existing weather stations. The Board suggests contacting community groups such as ag societies and 4H clubs to do site maintenance such as mowing and barrier repair. These groups are always looking for fundraising ideas.



CLEAR HILLS COUNTY

The Board appreciates the opportunity to provide suggestions and feedback on the work that ACIS is doing. The work that ACIS does is very valuable to our producers and we want to be a part of making it even better in the future.

In this regard, the Board would like to request a meeting between yourself and Clear Hills County administration to discuss how Clear Hills County could help with this process. We would like to have the opportunity to discuss having ACIS use Clear Hills County as a pilot project to test possible solutions to improving weather data accuracy across the province.

OTHER TOPICS

- 1. Right of way spraying has been ongoing, concentrating on sow thistle on the shoulders and prominent patches of Canada Thistle.
- 2. Weed inspectors have completed the Bertha Armyworm survey as well as the grasshopper survey. Bertha numbers were well below economic thresholds but grasshoppers were at or above economic thresholds in most areas of the county other than Bear Canyon, which had little to no grasshoppers this year.
- 3. Wheat head surveys will begin soon. We will be surveying and collecting samples for Alberta Agriculture and Irrigation in four wheat fields this year.
- 4. Clubroot surveys will be doubled this year from 25 fields to 50 fields this year due to the discovery last year.
- 5. The mowers have completed a full cut in Bear Canyon, Cleardale, Royce, and Hines Creek and we have done a shoulder cut from Worsley east to the eureka mailboxes.
- 6. Council resolved to declare an agricultural disaster due to drought conditions within Clear Hills County at the Aug 12th meeting.
